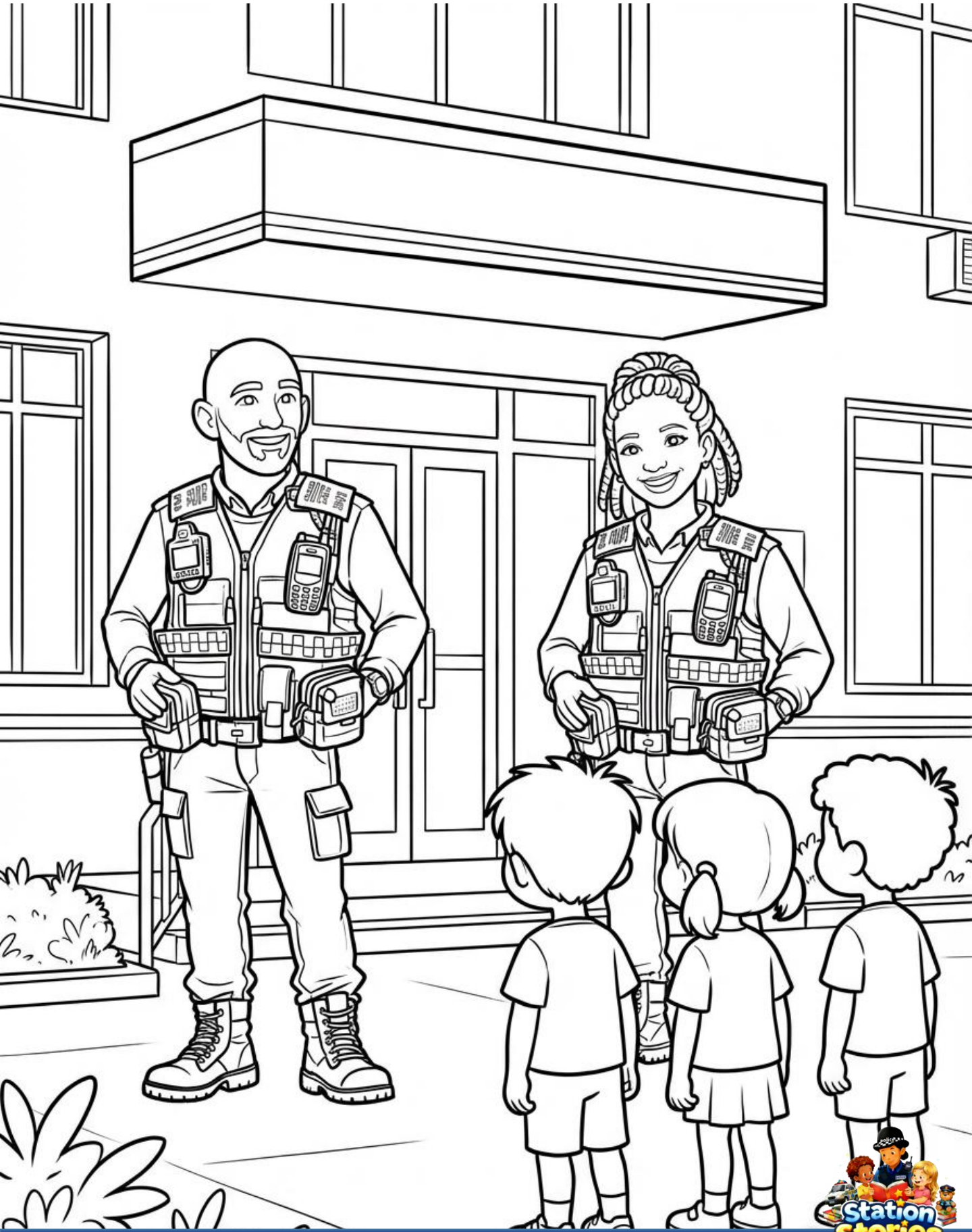




Police station visit

an officer said.



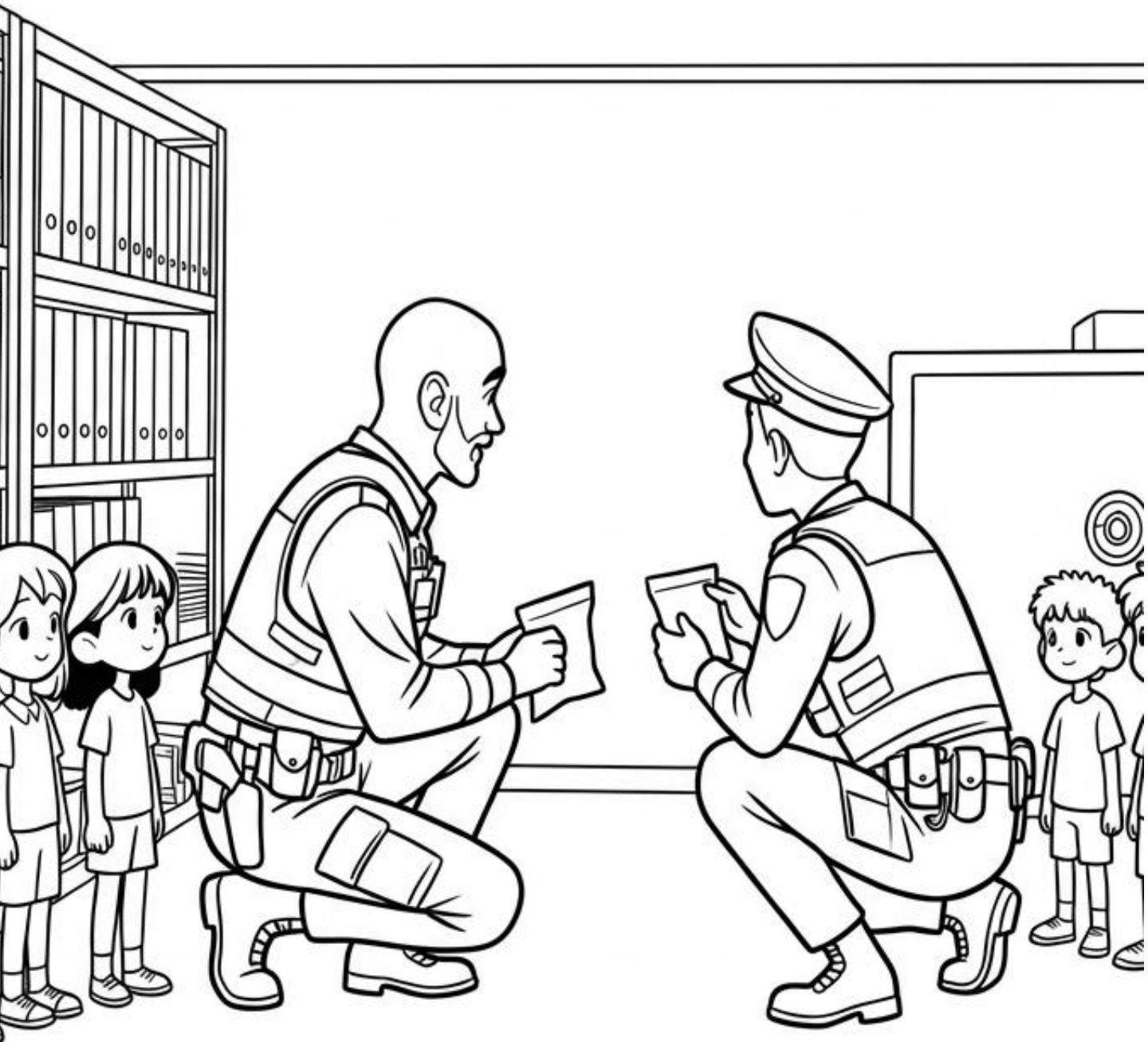
Upstairs, CID showed them how detectives look for clues, just like super-sleuths!
