She reassures Sam: "don't worry, we'll find Mr Snuggles together."



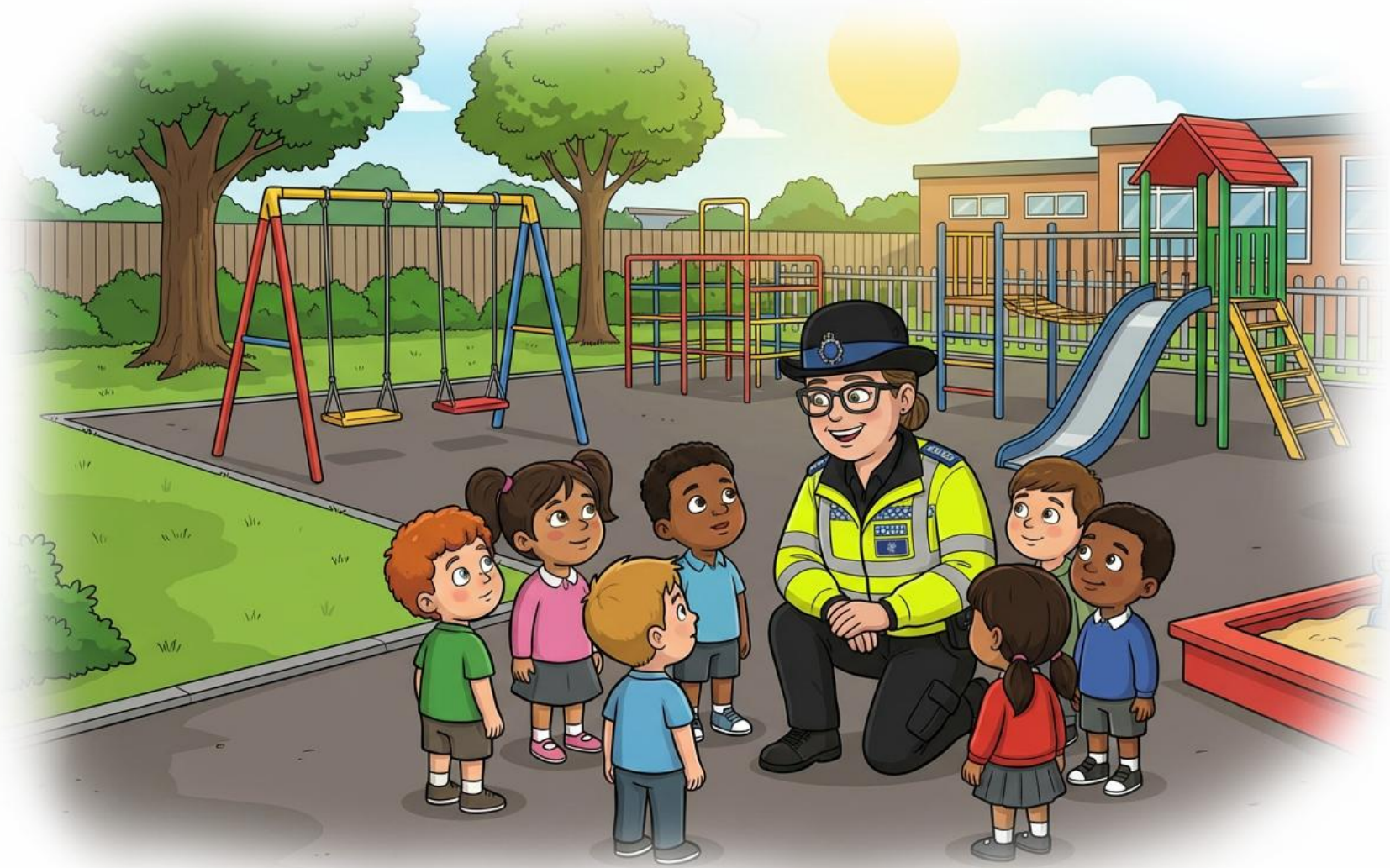
Helen looks for clues:  
muddy footprints near the sandbox.



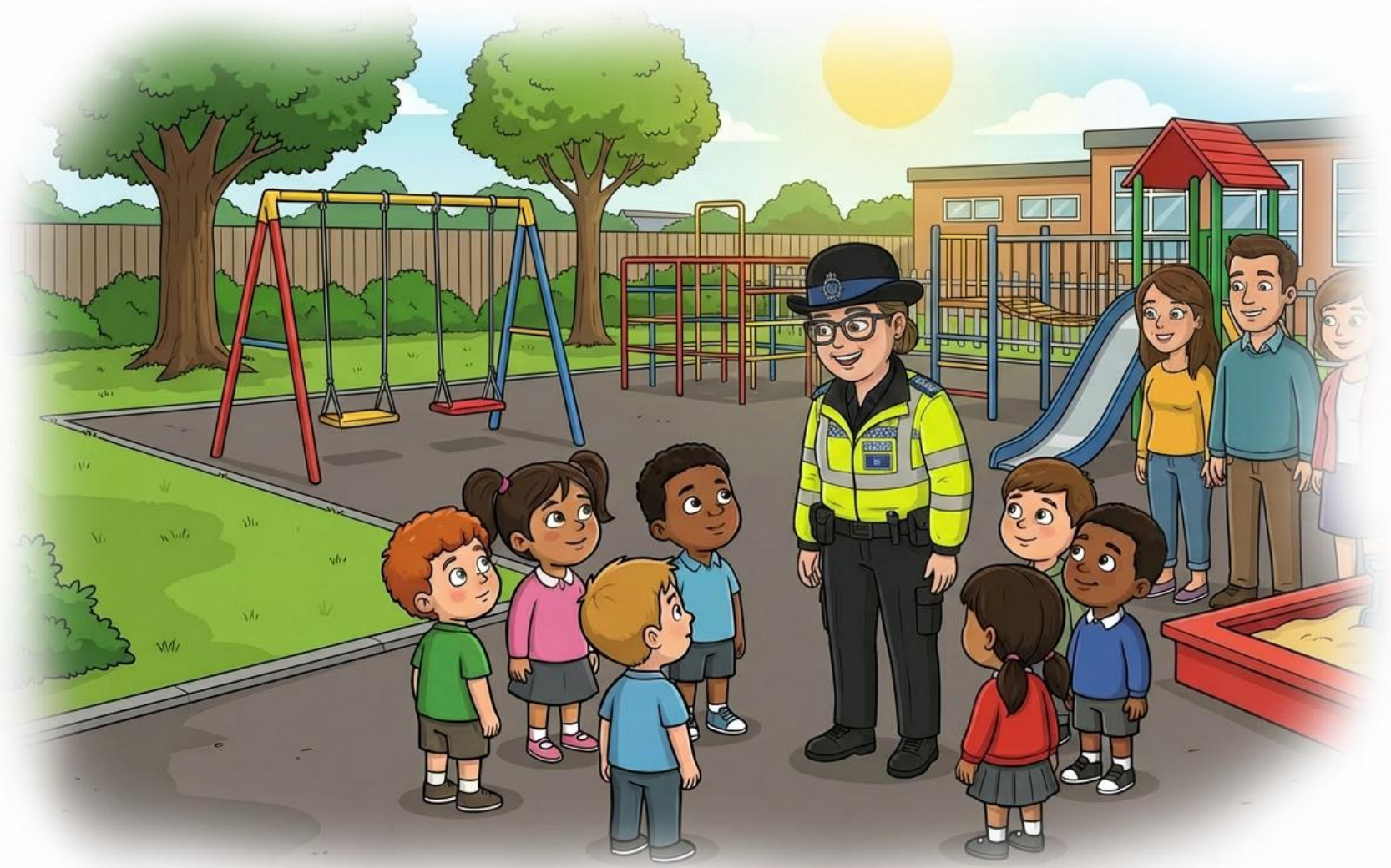
Biscuits crumbs leading towards the playground.
