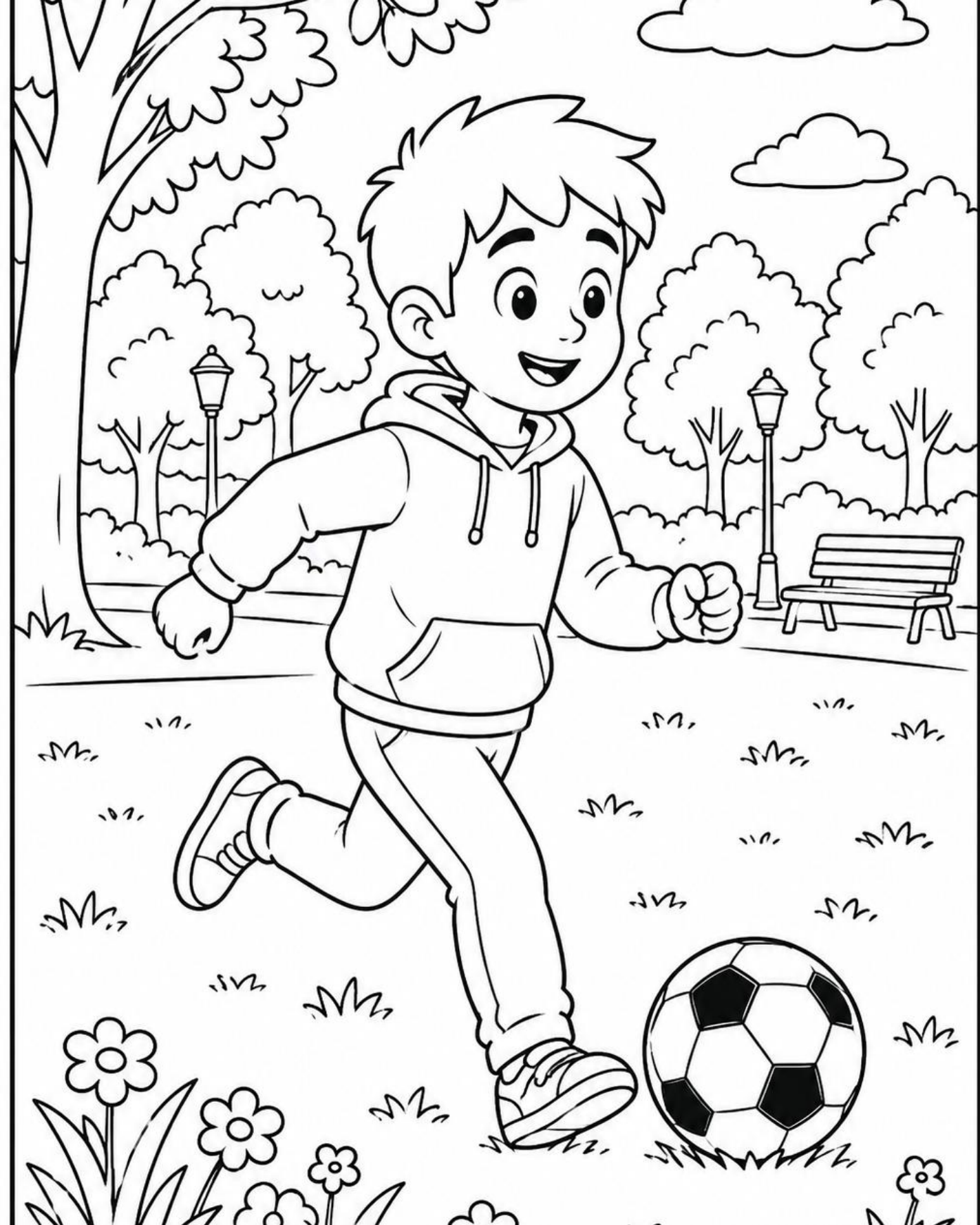
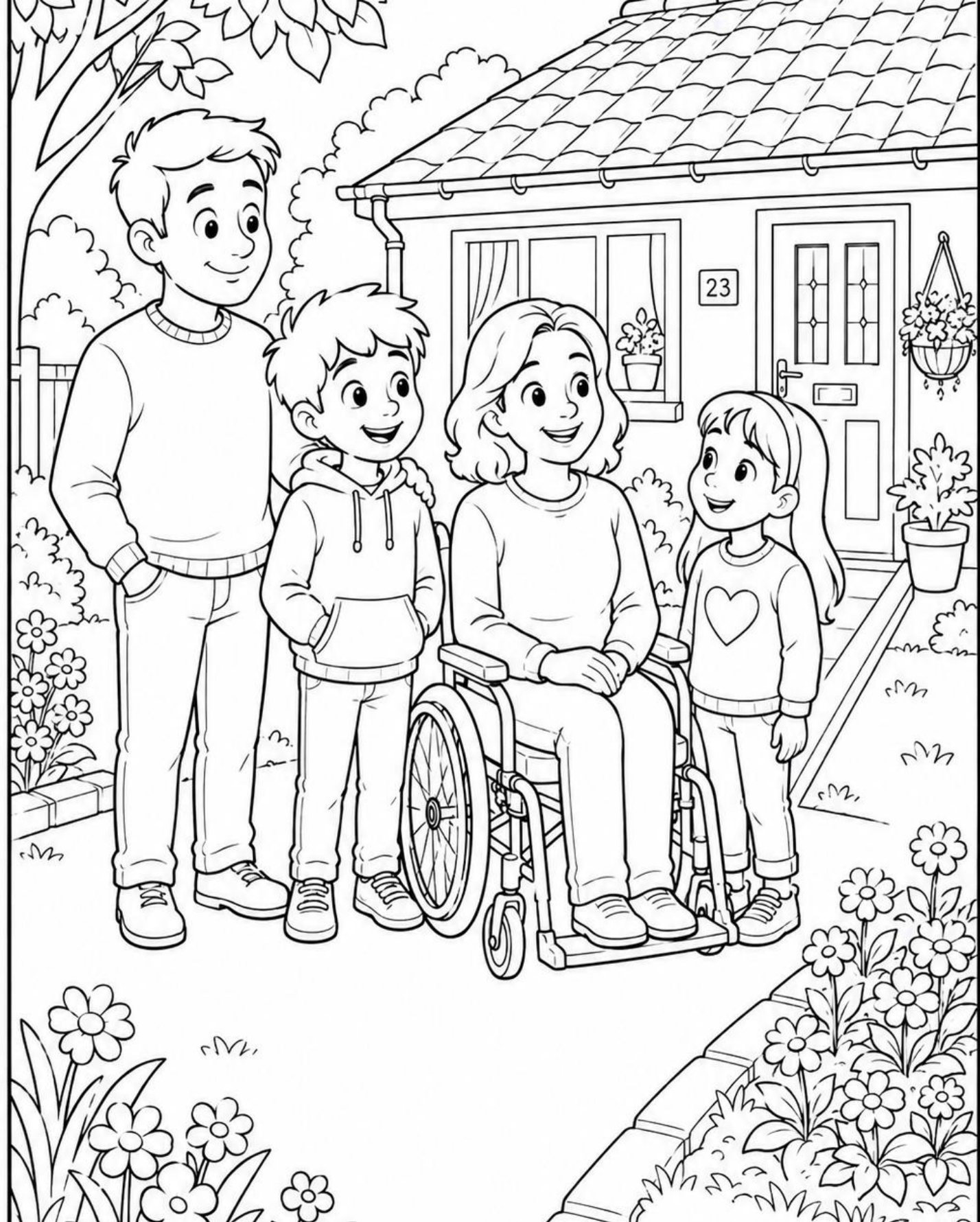




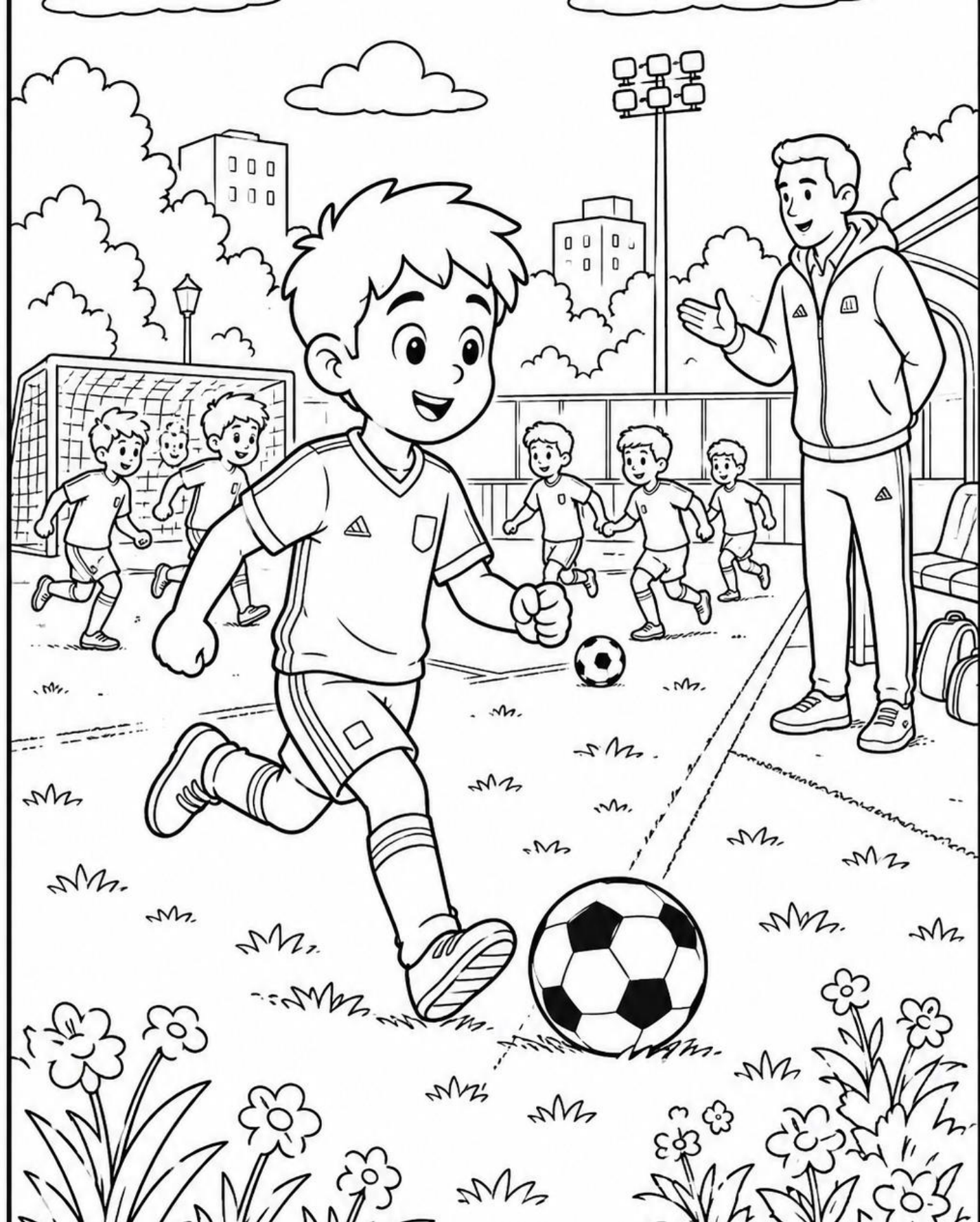
**Kyle goes to a
football game**



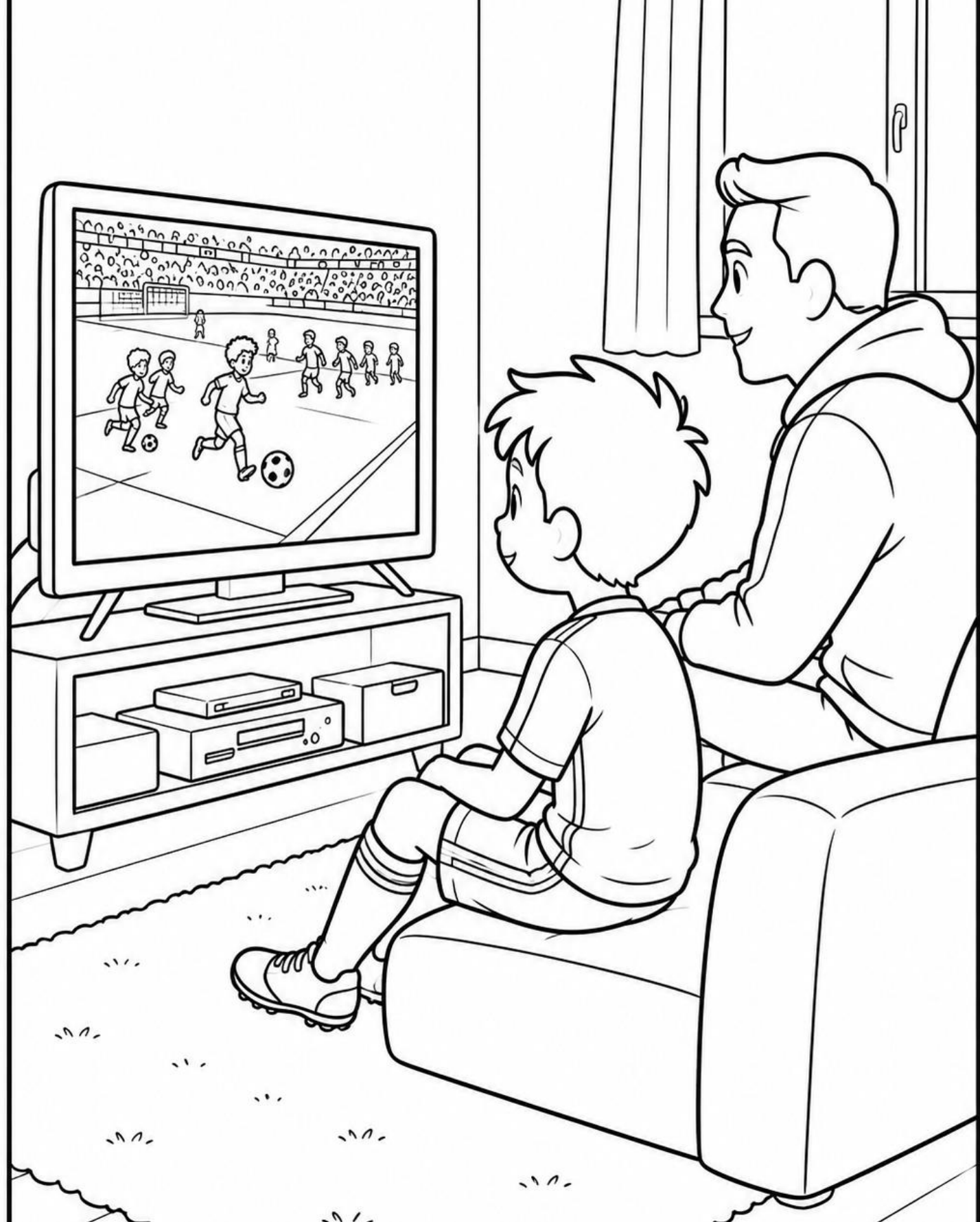
Kyle likes playing football after school and at weekends.
He wants to be a footballer when he grows up.



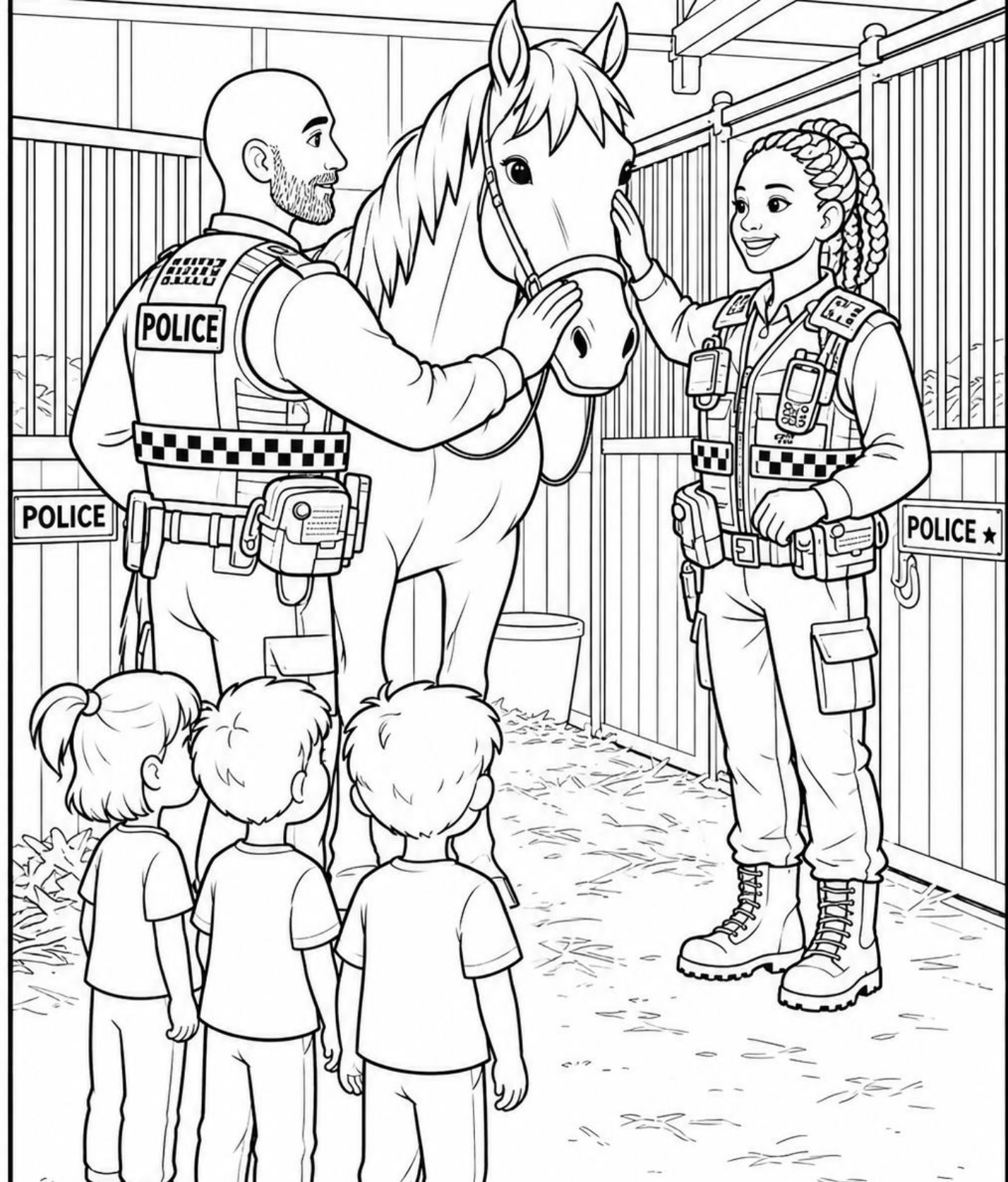
Kyle lives with his mum, dad, and his sister

The team is coached by his dad, they play matches against other teams.



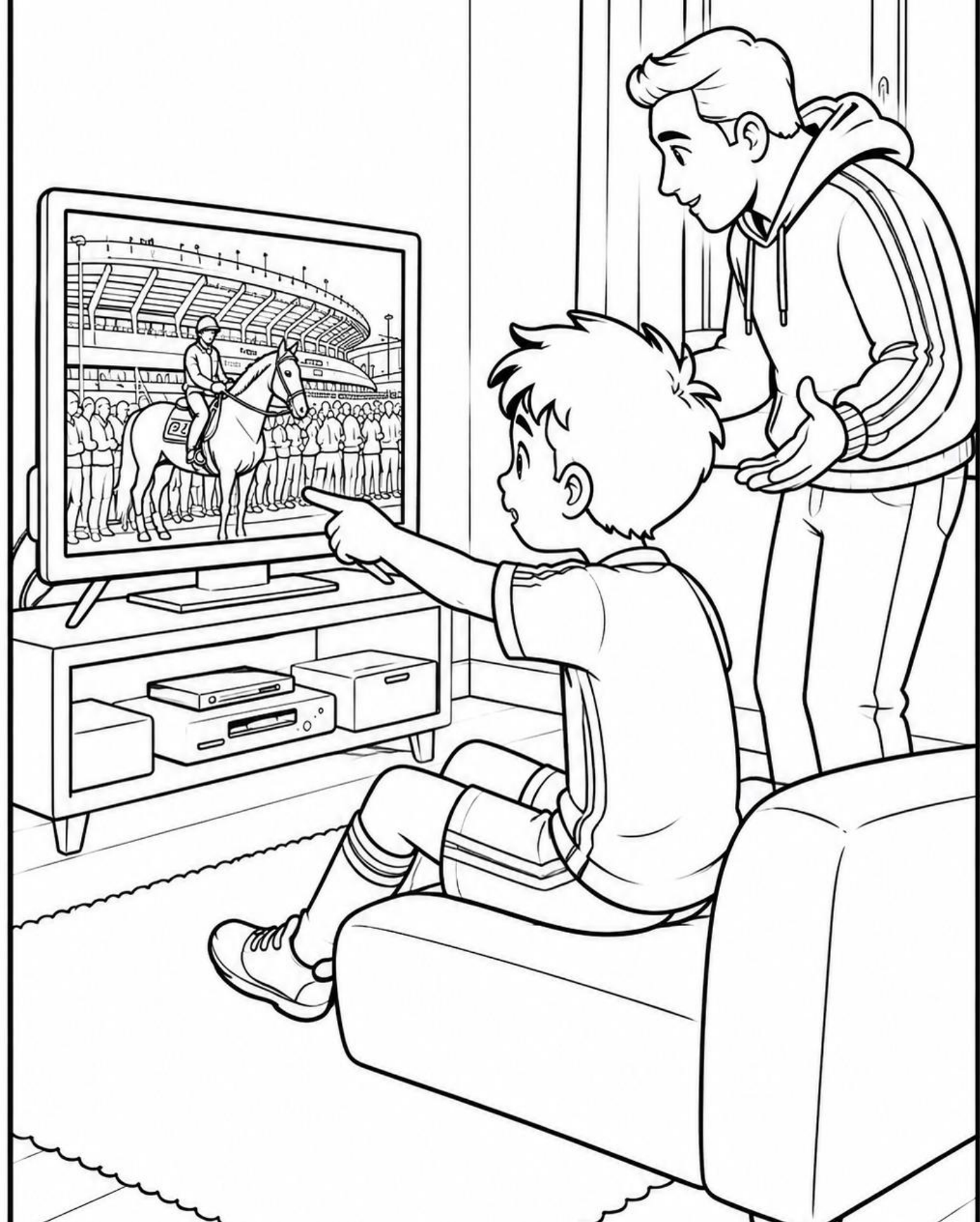

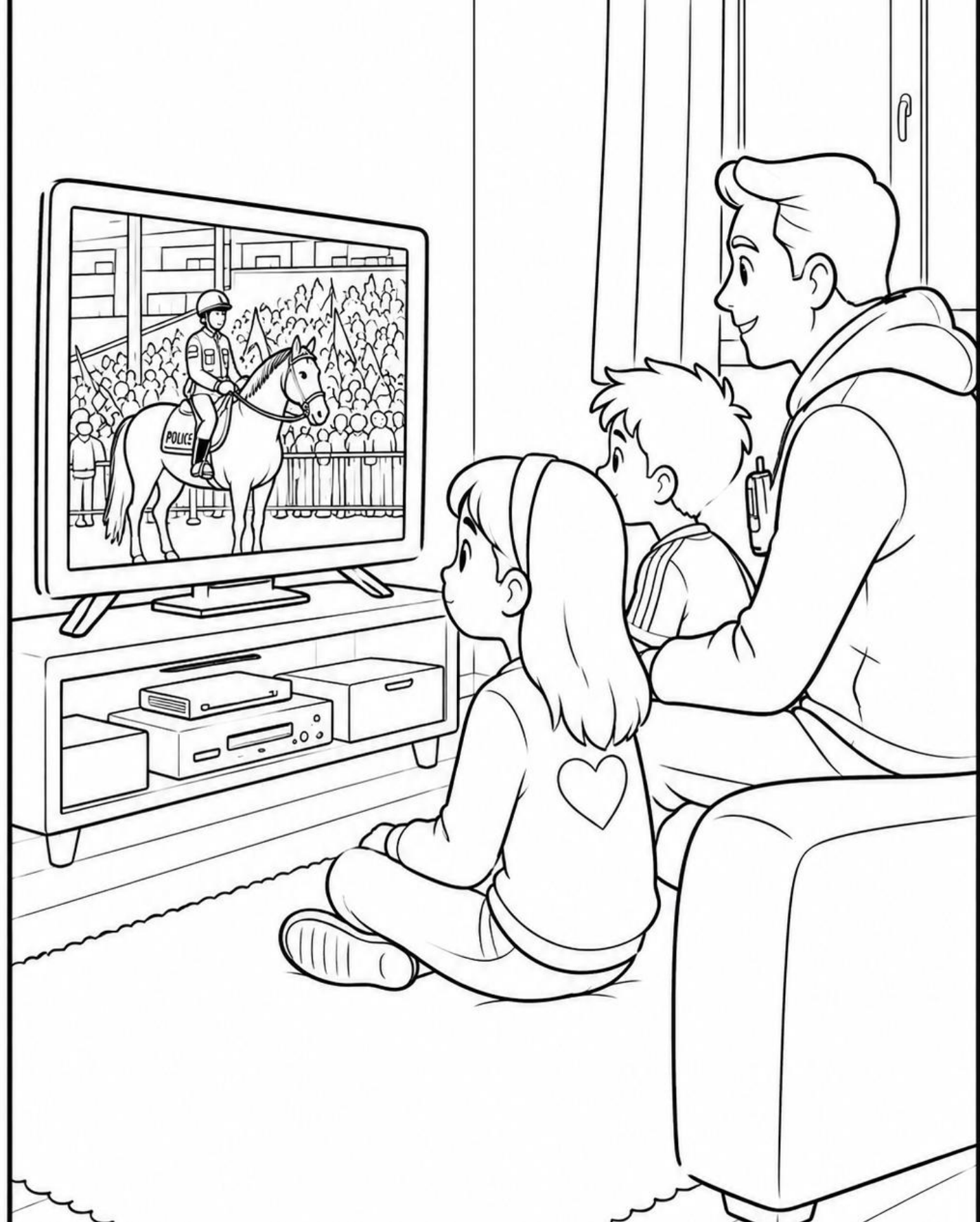

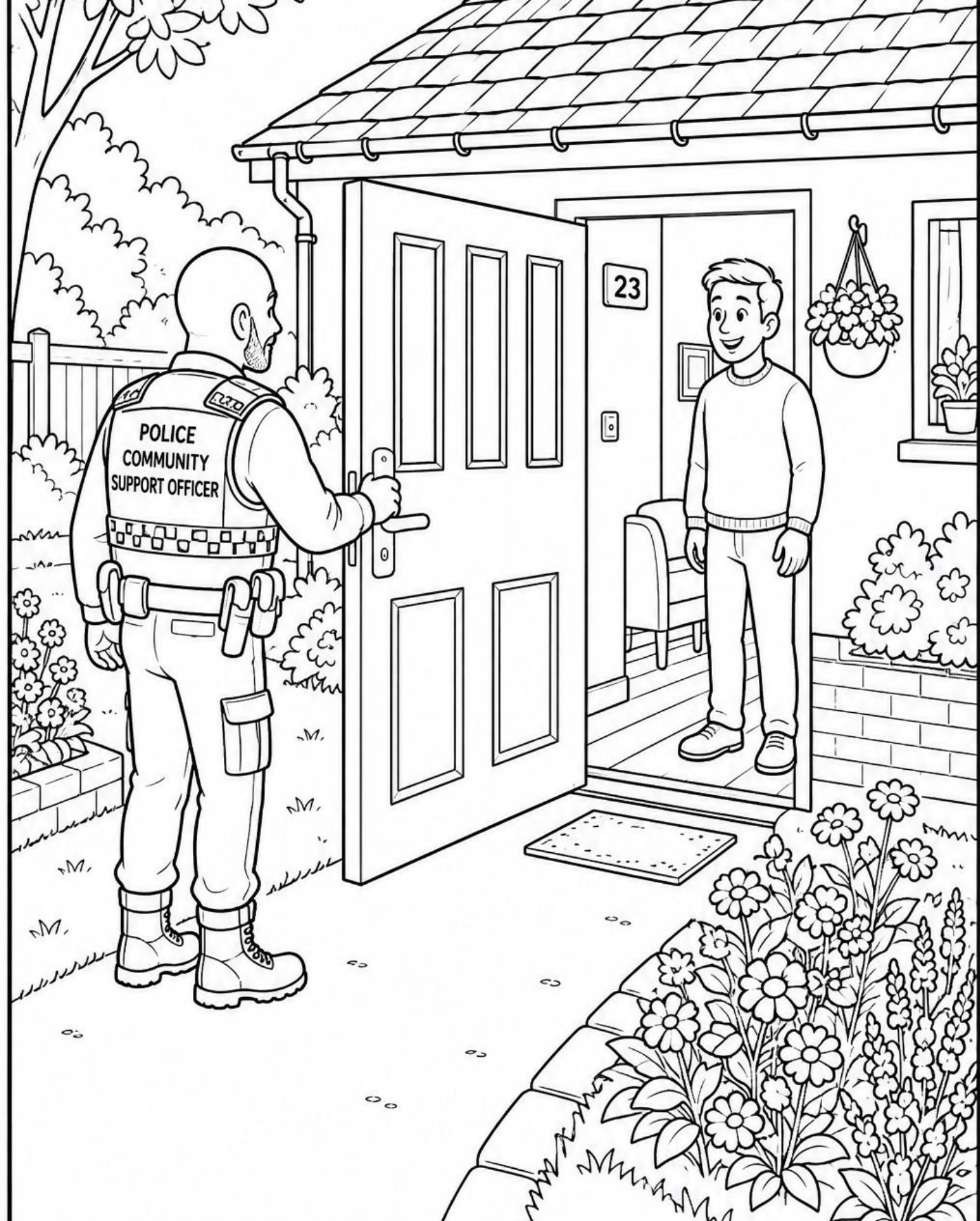


Kyle said "I would love to go to a match and see the police horses." "We will go one day" promised his dad. Kyle frowned, "what about mum?" he asked.



Dad said he would ring the station and ask about wheelchair access to the stadium, I will leave a message for PCSO Sam or PCSO Aisha. I will ask them to call me."

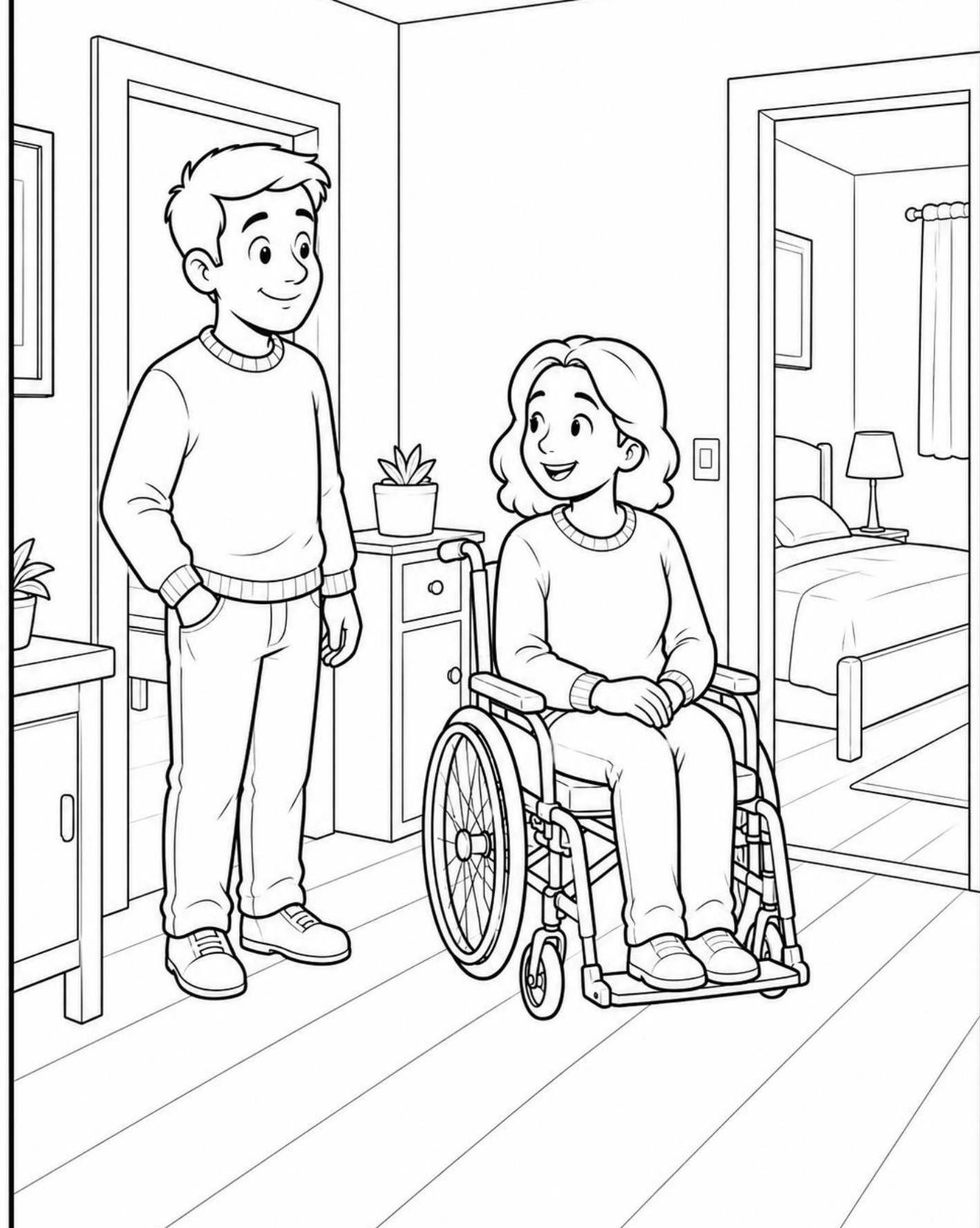
Kyle nodded and smiled "it wouldn't be the same without mum."

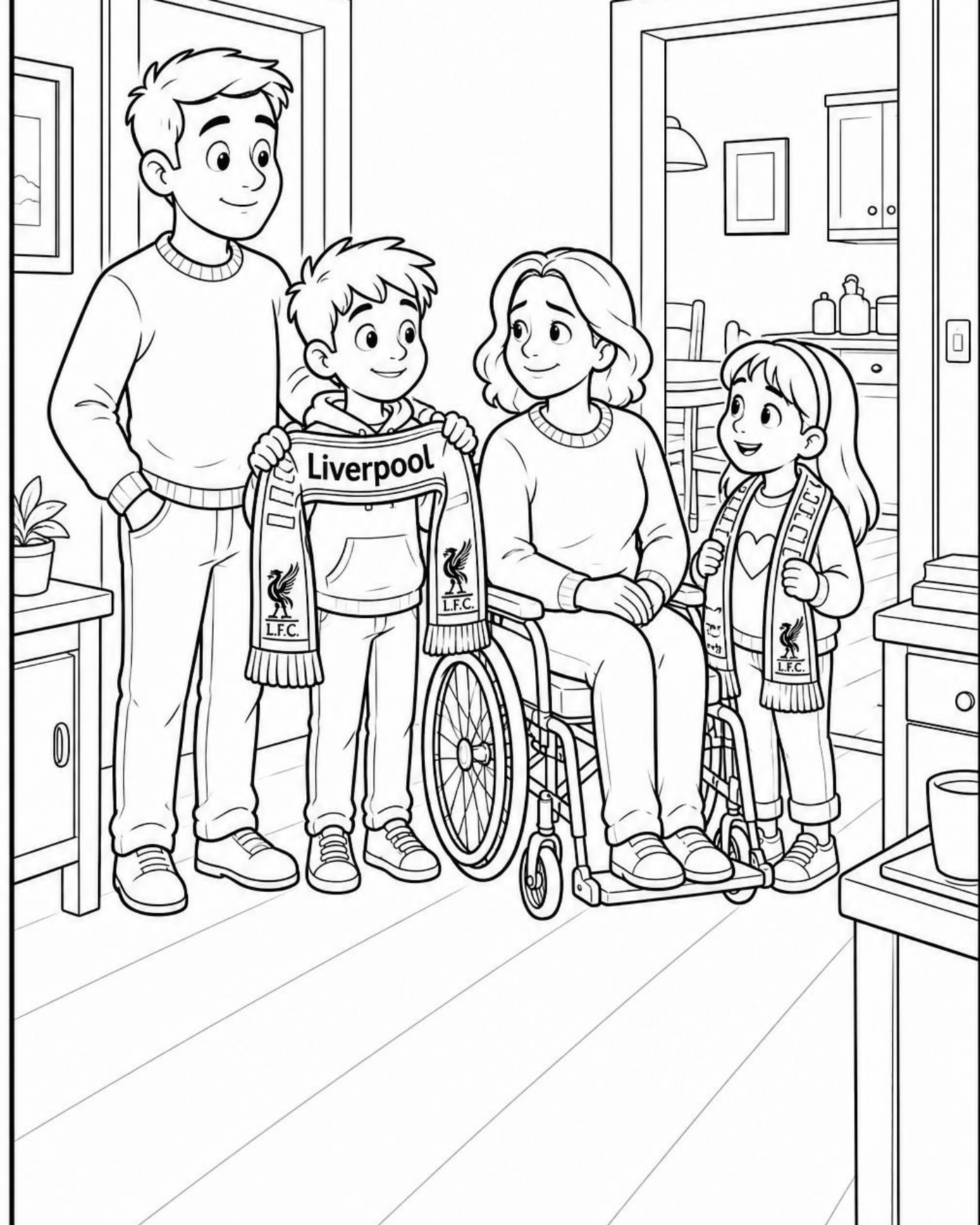

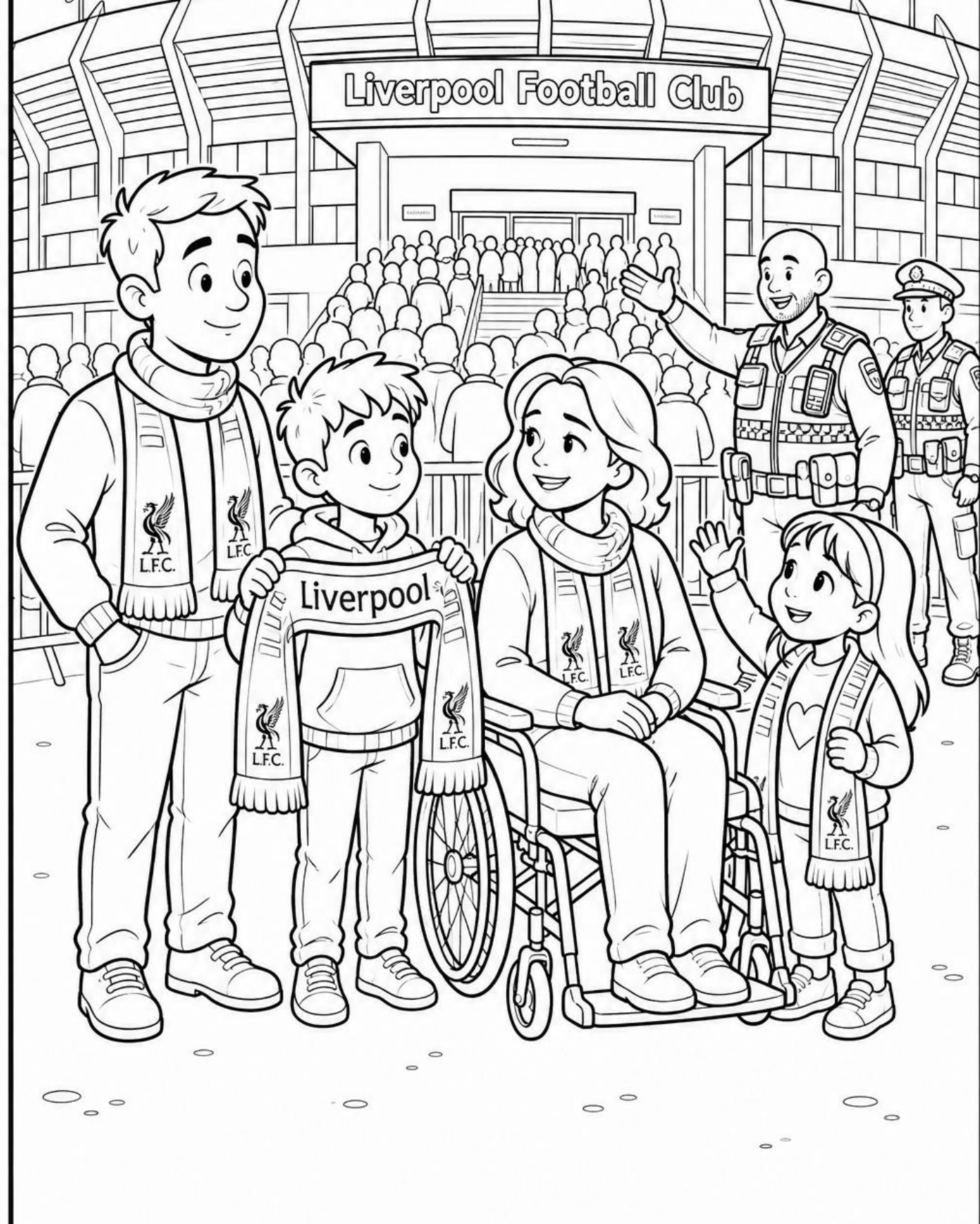
Kyle's mum looked pleased. I would like to go with you all to a match. I was worrying about the crowds of people.



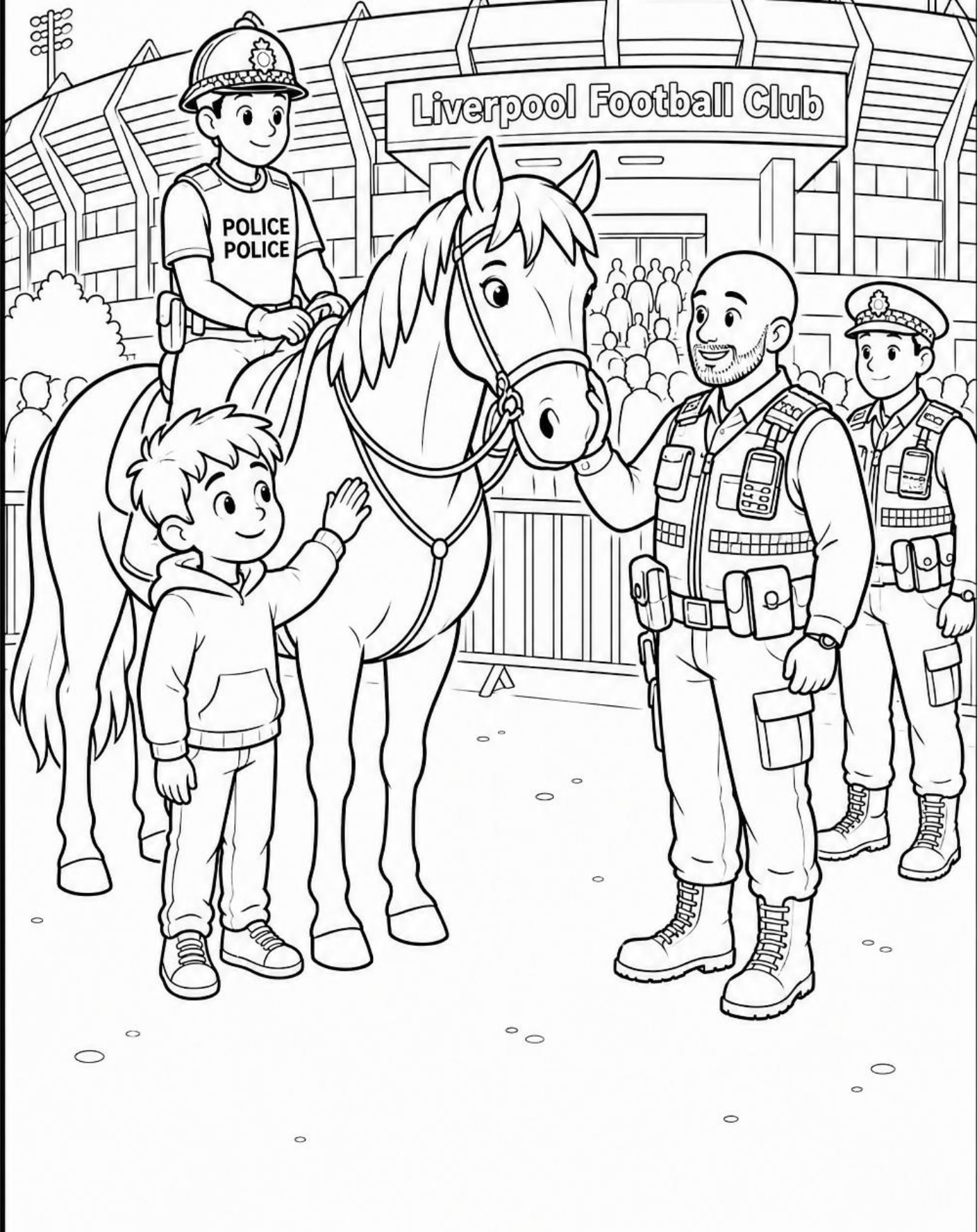

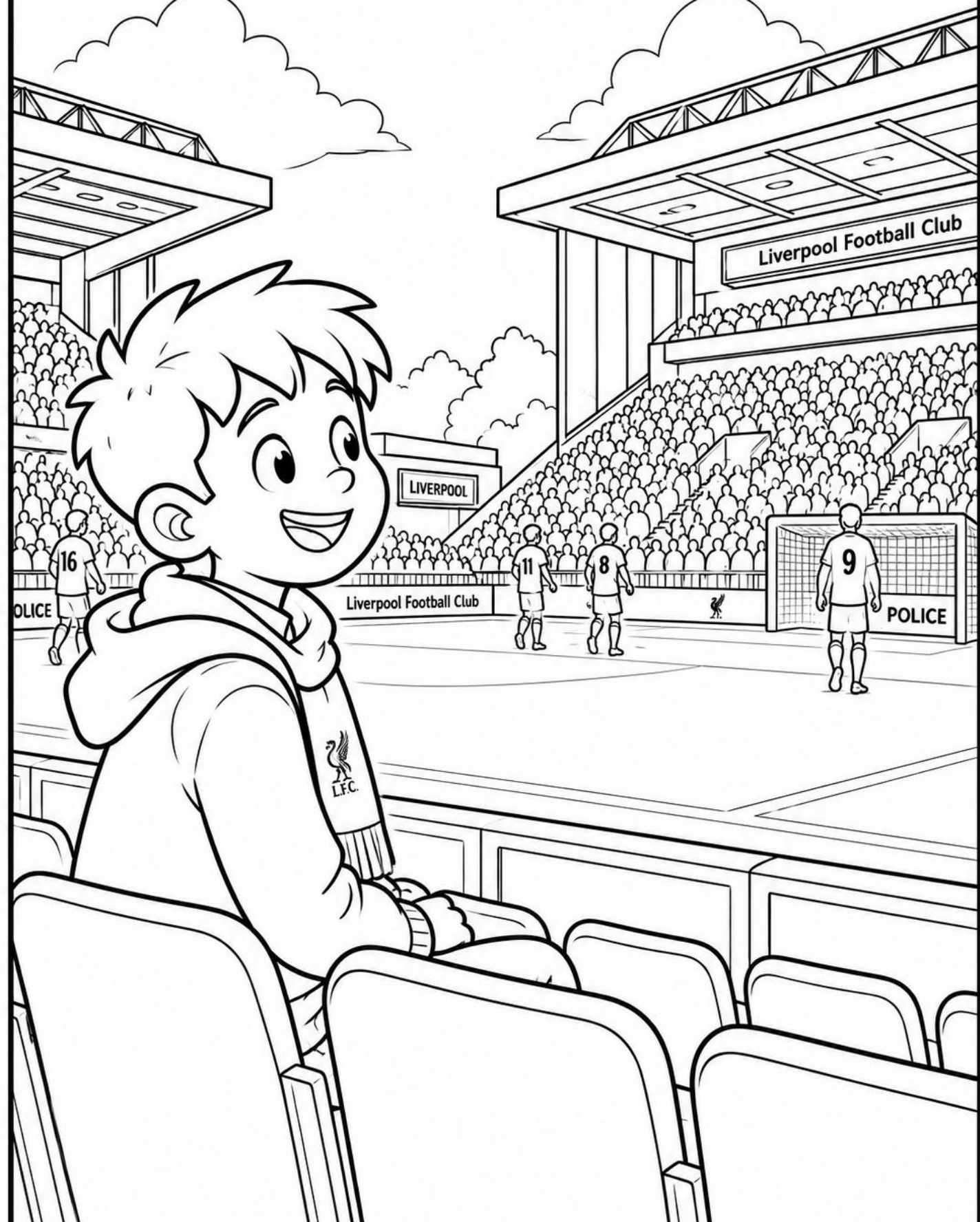
Kyle was really excited about going to the match, even Jasmine was a bit excited! Their parents ordered tickets for the next match and bought them Liverpool scarves.
