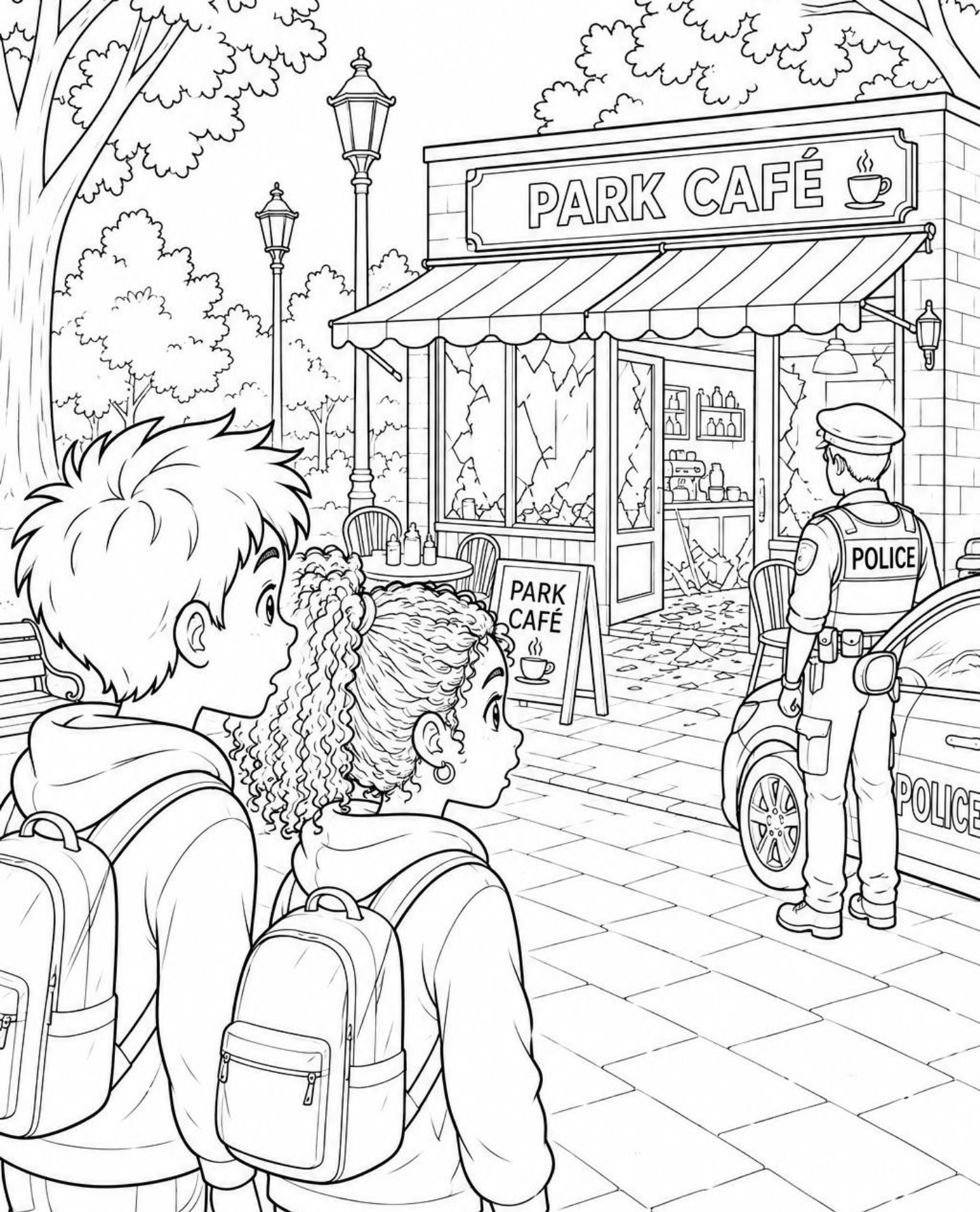




The clever clues

The officers worked slowly and carefully.



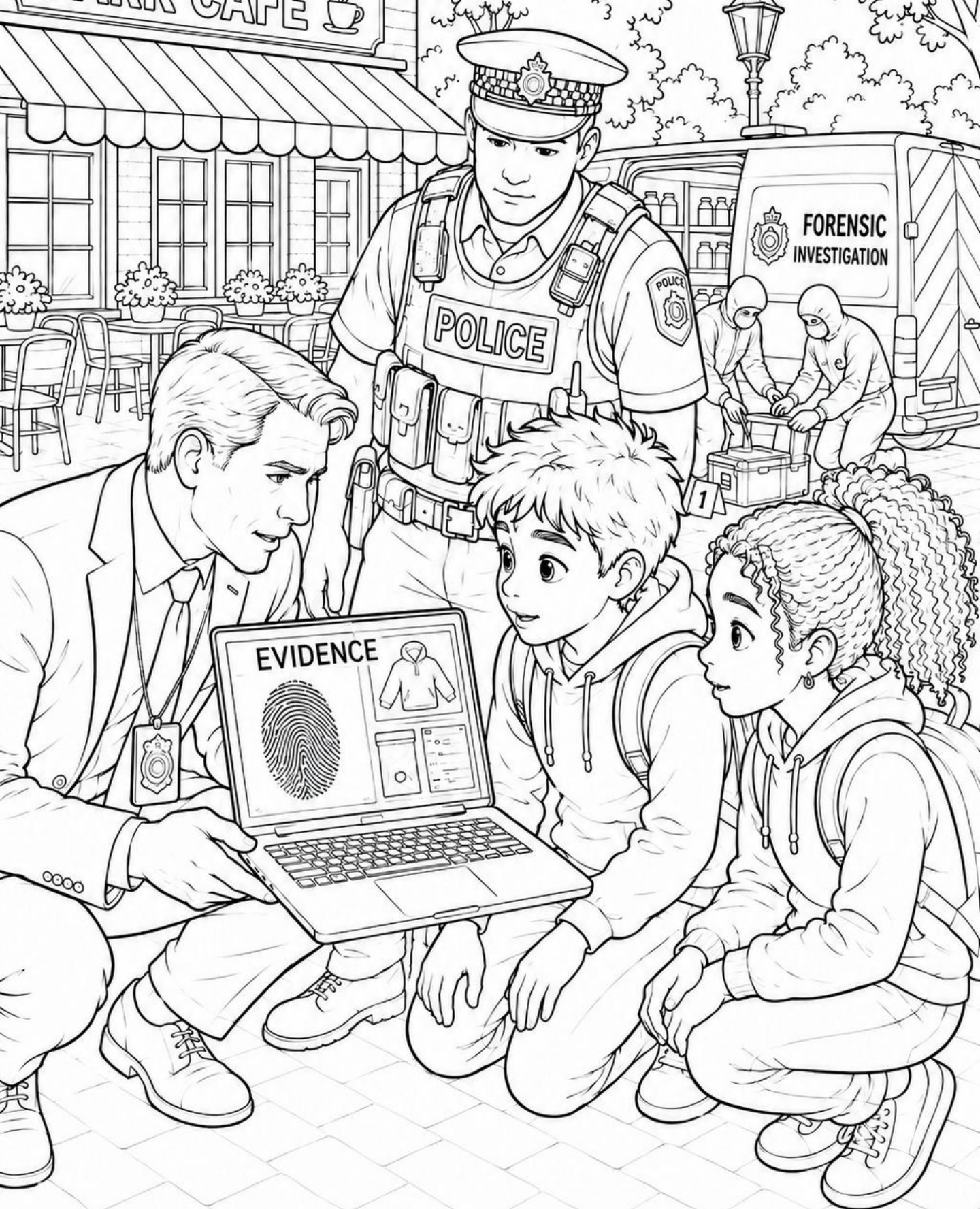
Police officers, detectives, and forensic teams,

Everyone had an important job to do.



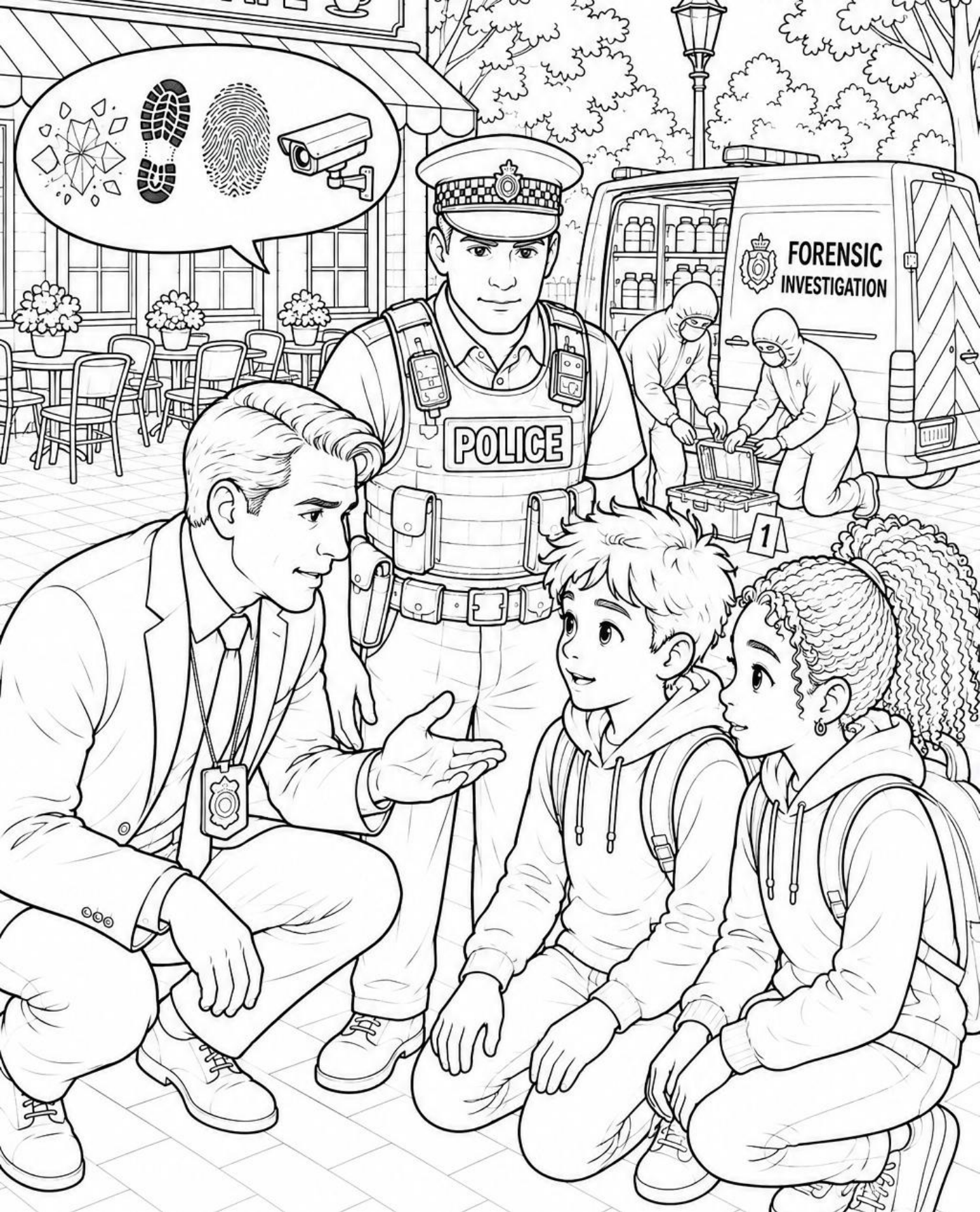
The detective studied the clues, which helped them to identify the person who did this.
