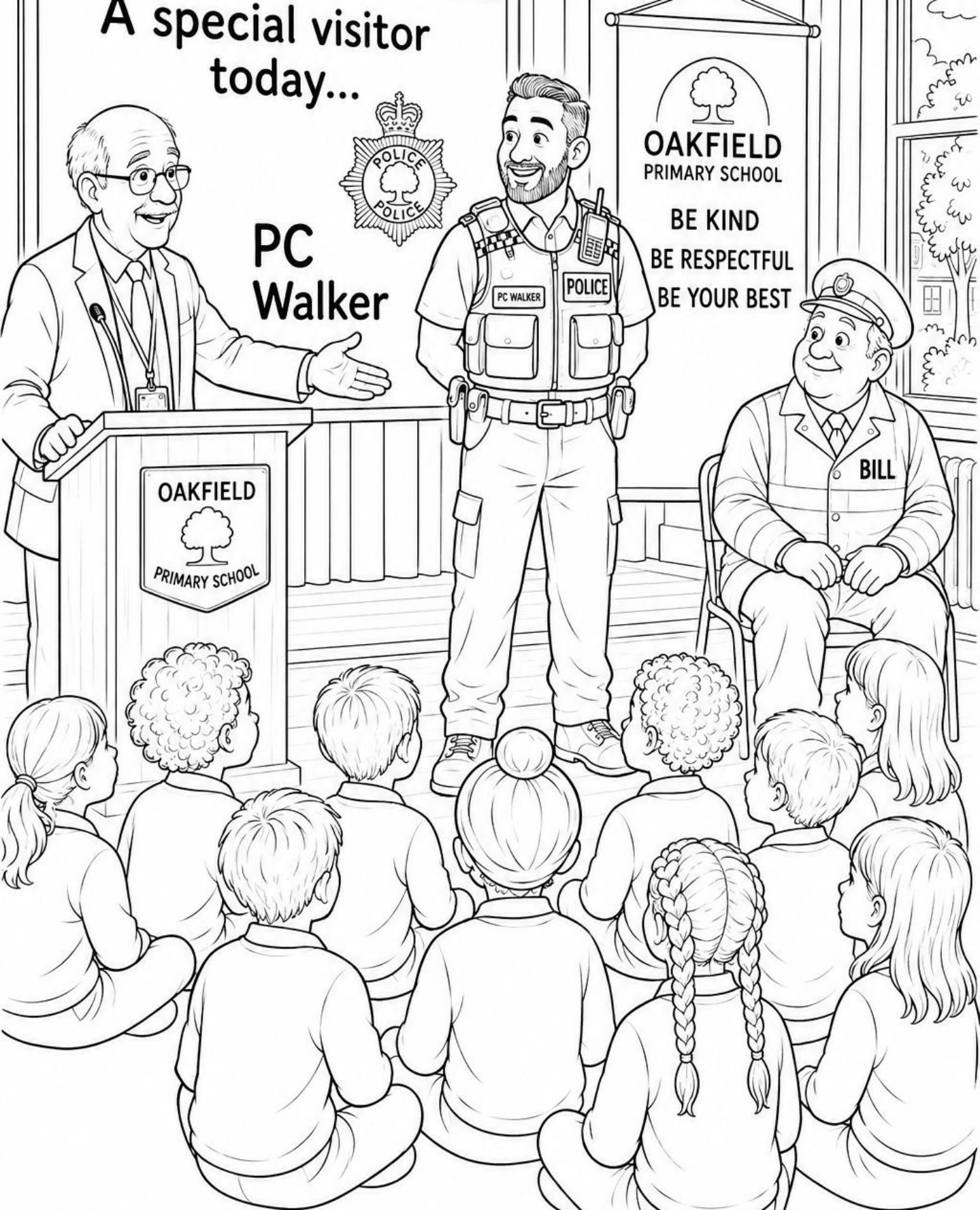

**3****LOOK LEFT**

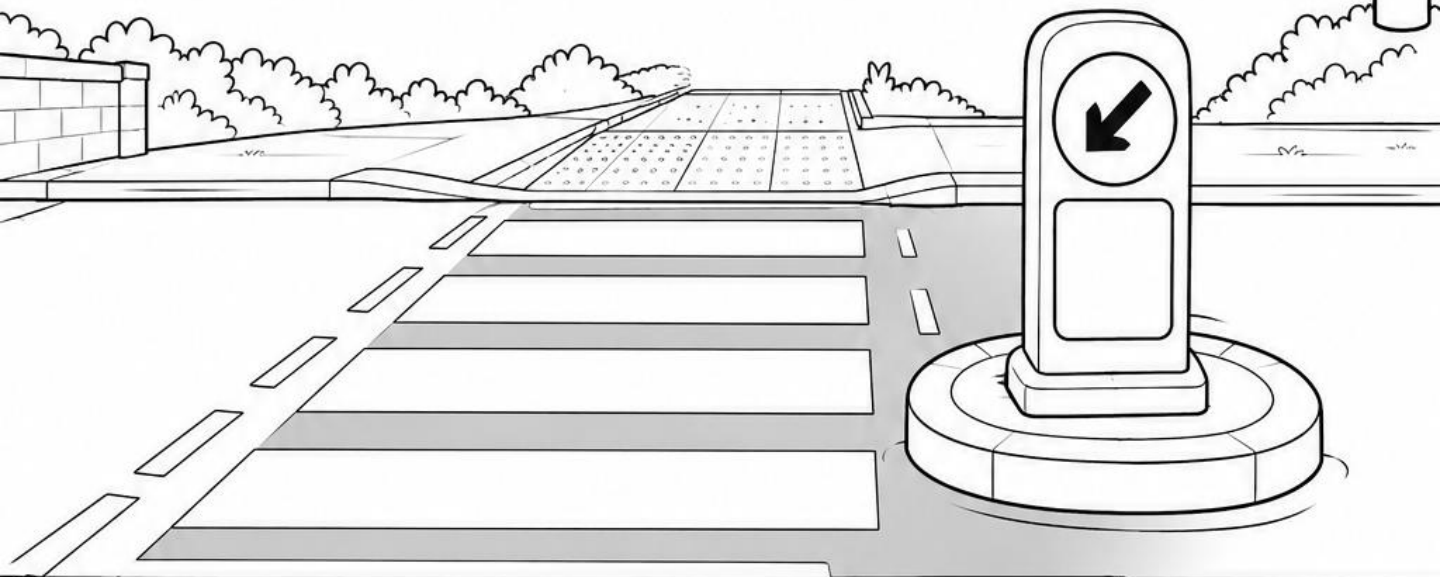
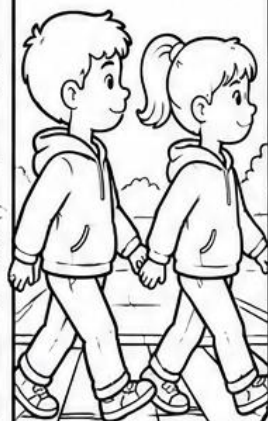
Look left

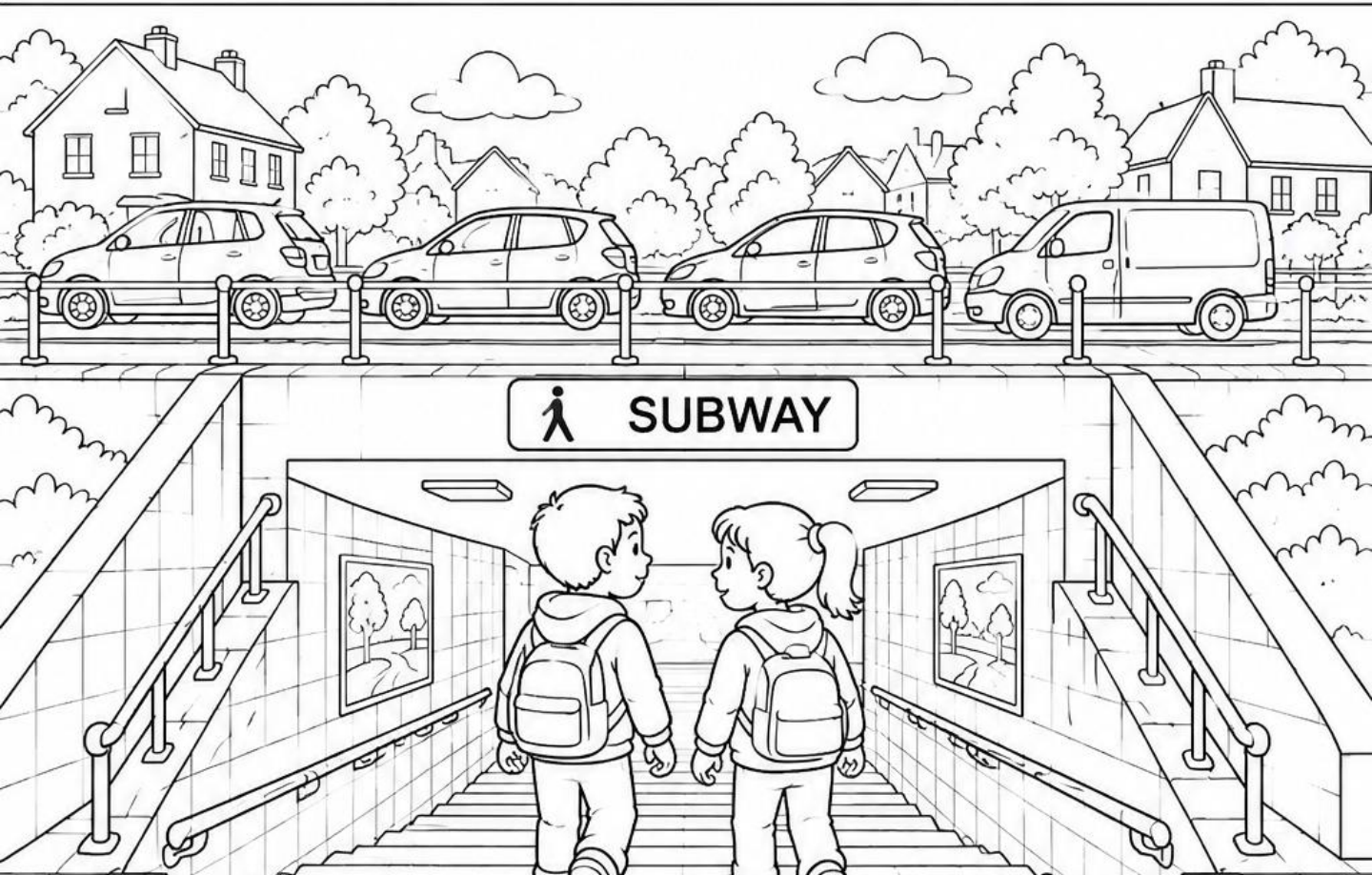
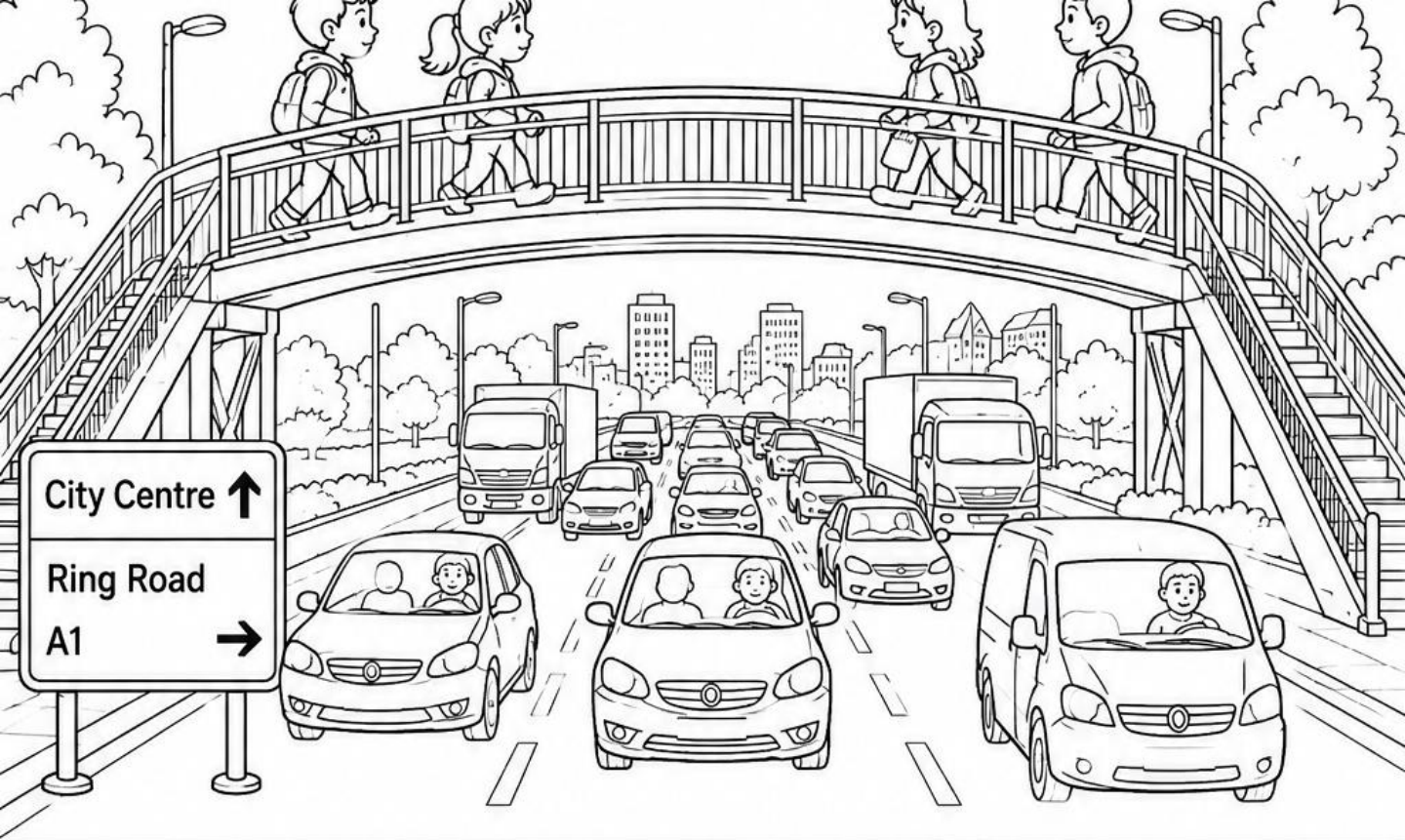


**Stop, Look, Listen,
Think. Stay Safe!**

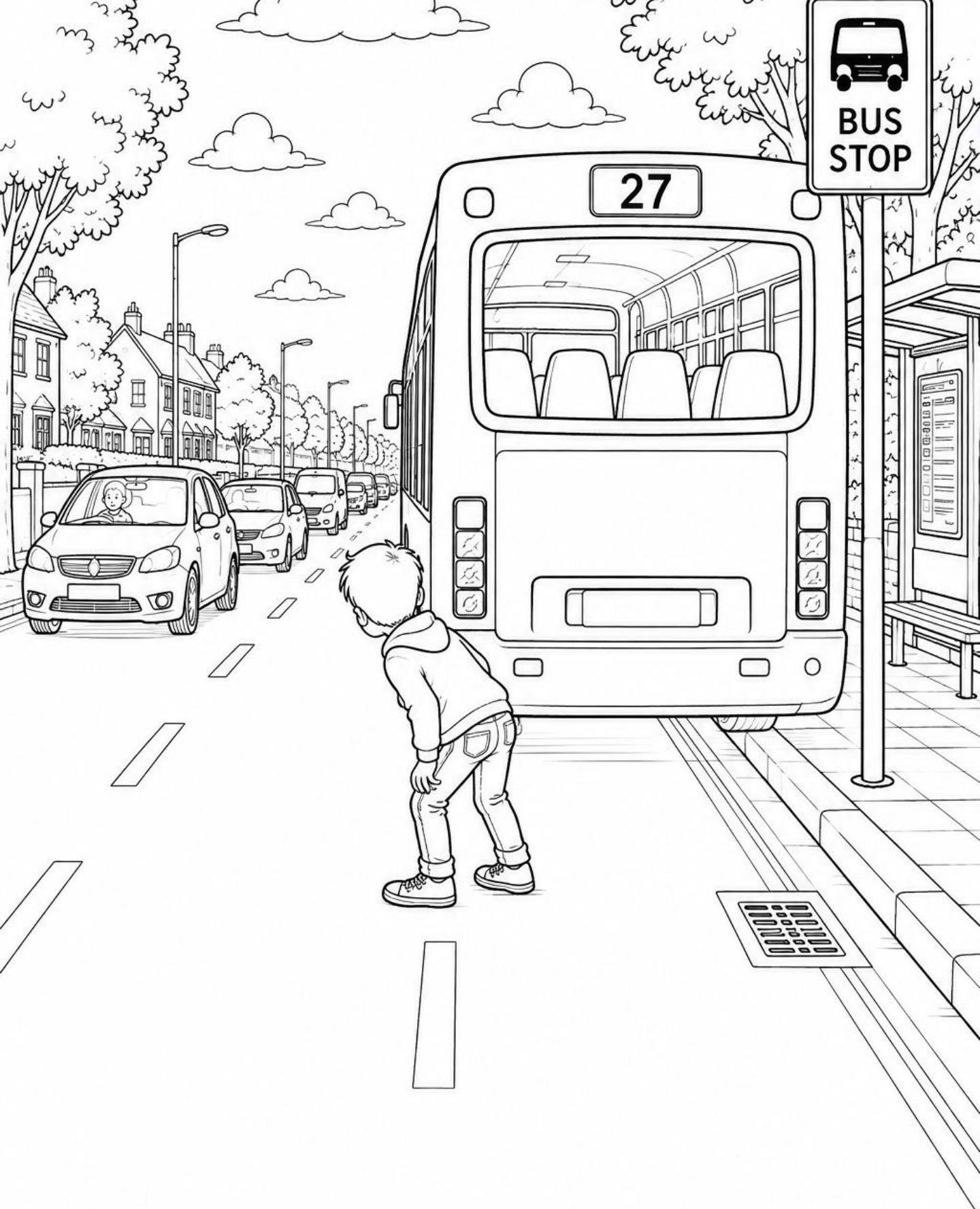
PC Walker shows them a picture on the screen
 "There are lots of times when you need to cross the road.
 The Green Cross Code helps you to do so safely. You need to
 stop, look, listen, and wait."



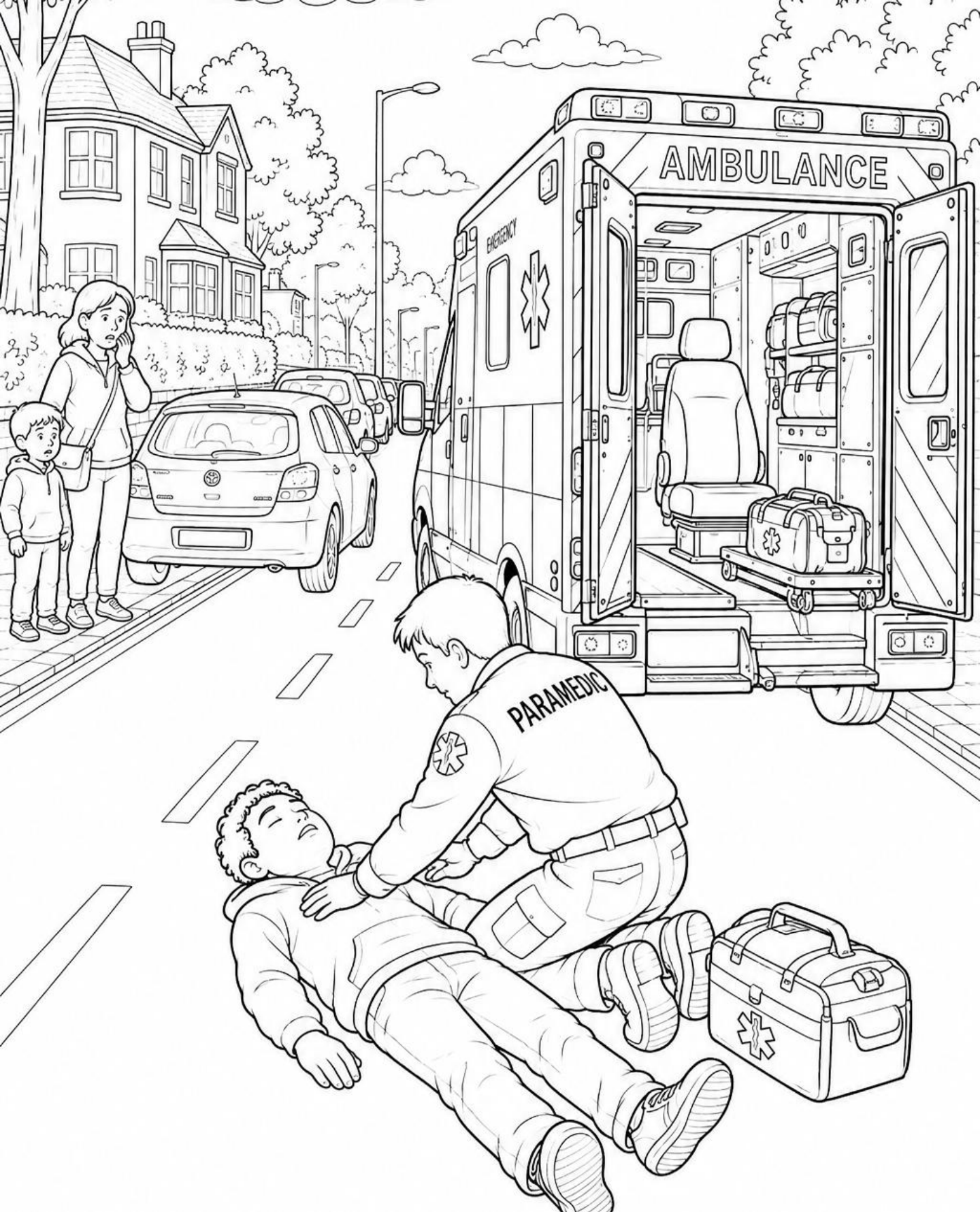
"When you stop, and look, you might see black and white markings on the road. These tell you that they are a safe place to cross. Some have buttons you can press to tell you when it is safe to cross. You still need to stop, look, listen, and wait, till it is safe to cross."



"It is not safe to try to cross roads which are much wider and have lots of traffic. When you stop and look, you might see a road bridge or a subway. They are there to provide you with a safe way to cross the road. Always use these if they are there."



"On all roads, always make sure you can see the traffic, don't step into the road from behind a car or a bus, you won't see the cars and they won't see you."



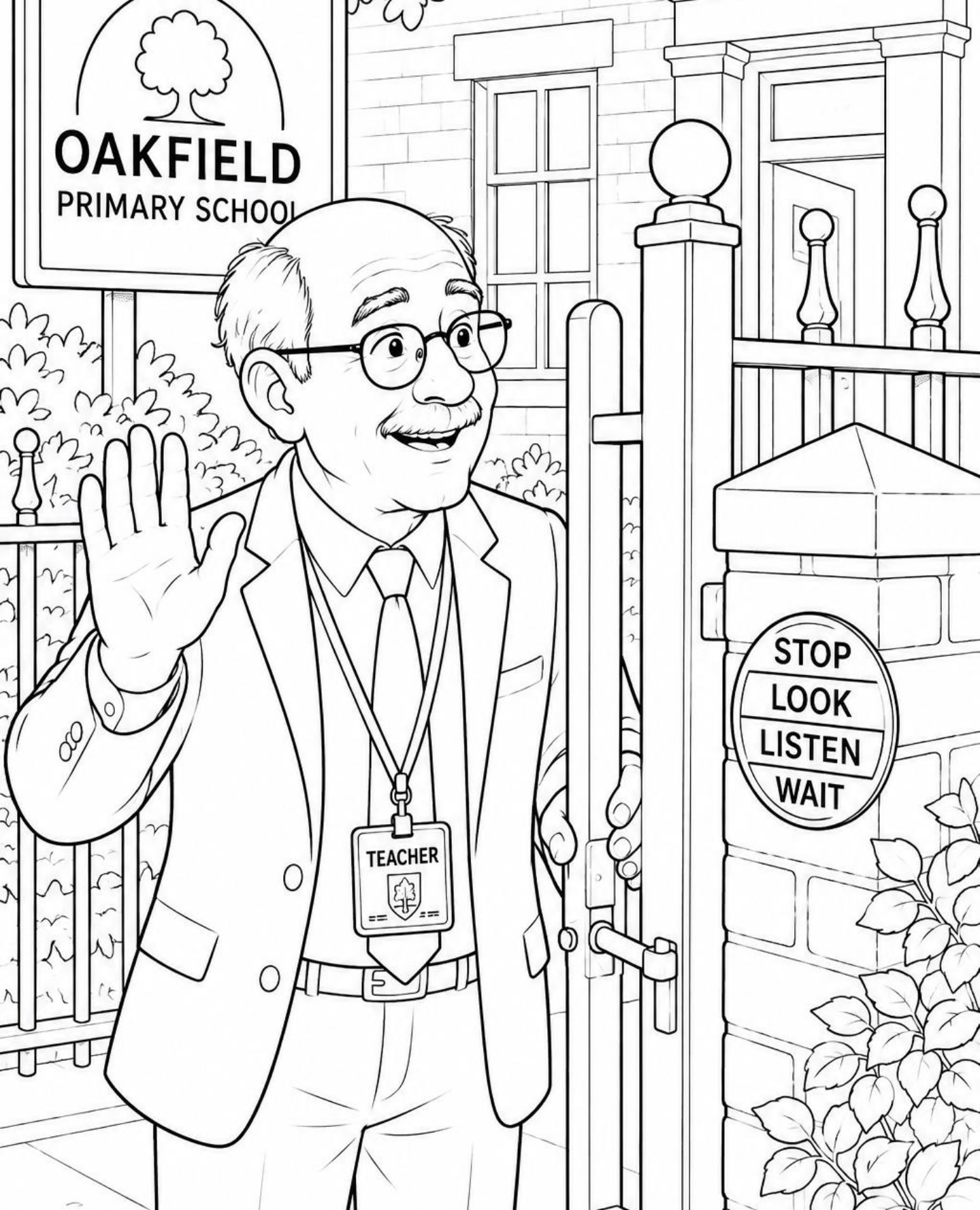
"Make sure you are always looking and listening as you cross, so you see or hear cars which are turning or overtaking other cars. If you are talking to your friends or looking at your phone, you could be hit by a car."



PC Walker finished his talk. He gave out badges for all the children. The badges had Stop, Look, Listen, and Wait, written on them. Kiran pinned his badge on his jumper, and grinned at William and Anas.



The next morning, the boys were standing by Bill waiting to cross to school. Bill smiled at them and quietly said "well done lads." When Bill saw a gap in the traffic, he stepped out into the road and put up his stop sign, so they could cross safely.
